SPEA S.P.A. commitment is to be compliant with all applicable laws and regulations of countries where SPEA S.P.A. operates.

### **RoHS Directive compliance (Directive EU 2015/863)**

SPEA hereby declares and guarantees that all products have been designed and manufactured in compliance with the EU RoHS Directive (2015/863/EU) on the restriction of the use of hazardous substances in electronic components.

### **REACH compliance (Regulation EU 1907/2006)**

SPEA is a user according to the REACH Regulation because it operates downstream in the production chain and does not introduce any chemical transformation on the products it purchases. For this reason, SPEA verifies and declares that all its suppliers comply with the REACH Regulation.

### **Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment compliance (Directive EU 2012/19)**

SPEA confirms conformance with the regulations in force and fulfills the obligations arising under Directive 2012/19/EU. All equipment subject to the Directive is marked with the logo of Appendix IX of the Directive and the information necessary for disposal is available in the user manual of the equipment.

### **Conflict Minerals (Regulation EU 2017/821)**

SPEA does not accept products whose production uses the following raw materials originating from countries where conflicts are taking place for their control or for their deposits: tin, tantalum, tungsten, gold, cobalt and mica. For this reason, SPEA requires all its suppliers to verify the origin of the raw materials used in the products supplied and to declare compliance with the legislation on Conflict Minerals.
